## Overview

College of Marin offers noncredit classes that are free, short-term, not given for credit, and not graded.

These noncredit classes are offered in the areas of English as a Second Language (ESL noncredit), ESL vocational, adaptive PE, and registered nursing review.

For noncredit class choices, please refer to the credit/noncredit class schedule (which includes day, evening, and Saturday hours) or call 415.457.8811.

Noncredit enrollment at the College increased in the past year. In spring 2018, a total of 1,613 students enrolled in the noncredit program, up from 1,210 in Spring 2017. The majority of these students enrolled in English as a Second Language (ESL) classes.

## Gender

The College's noncredit student population is composed of 46 percent men and 51 percent women. (Three percent of students did not report this information.)

## Geographic Location

Most College of Marin noncredit students reside in Marin County ( 95 percent). The majority of the remaining students reside in the East Bay and Sonoma County.
