

Overview

College of Marin offers noncredit classes that are free, not given for credit, and not graded.

These noncredit classes are offered in the areas of English as a Second Language (ESL noncredit), ESL vocational, adapted fitness, and registered nursing review.

For noncredit class choices, please refer to the credit/noncredit class schedule (which includes day, evening, and Saturday hours) or call 415.457.8811.

Noncredit enrollment at the College increased in the past year. In fall 2018, a total of 1,518 students enrolled in the noncredit program, up from 1,358 in Fall 2017. The majority of these students enrolled in English as a Second Language (ESL) classes.

Gender

The College’s noncredit student population is composed of 43 percent men and 53 percent women. Four percent of students did not report this information.

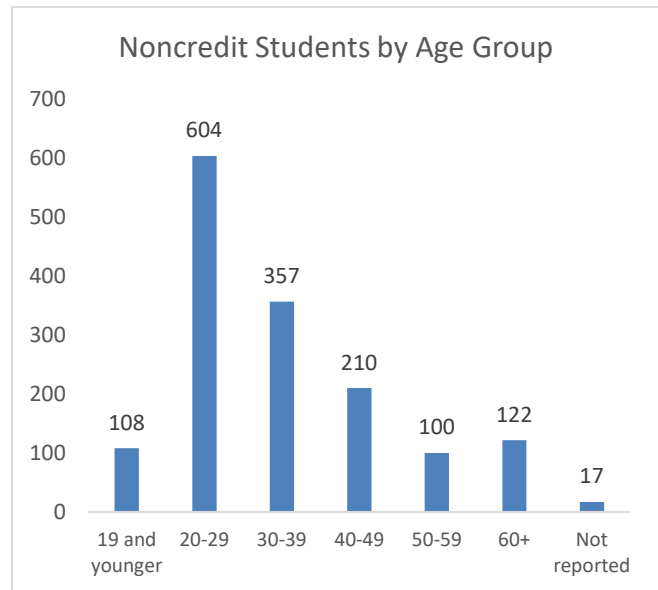
Geographic Location

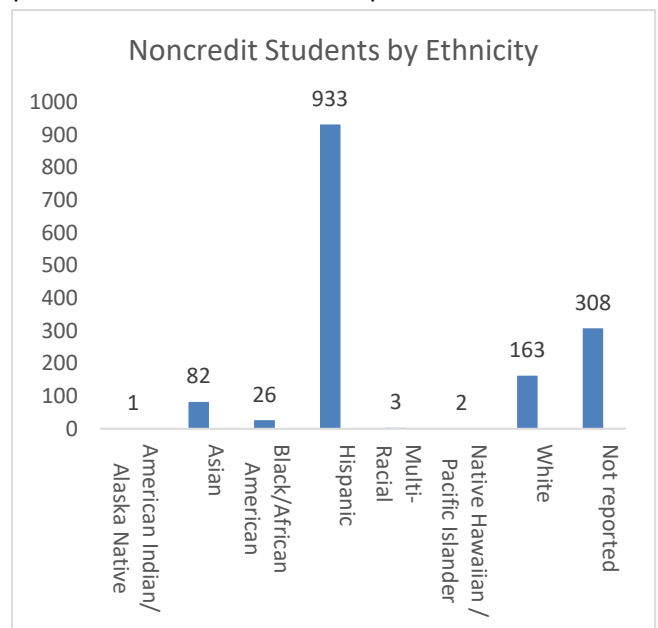
Age of Students

Fifty-three percent of the College’s noncredit students are 30 years of age or older. The median age of noncredit students is 31 years; the youngest is 18 and the oldest is over 80.
